


STREET WRAPPING PROJECT

Drawing on the successful concept of 'Yarn Bombing', the wrapping project will focus on bringing to life and taking over mundane street furniture, bollards and trees. The "wrapping" will challenge the way people view these objects as part of the everyday streetscape.

SITE

The wrapping will occur on multiple key objects along the Riverside Walk, within the National Australia Bank laneway and on High Street in Central Maitland. Objects include street benches, outdoor tables, bollards and street light posts.



The installation will remain for up to six weeks following the Aroma festival event (August 13, 2016), depending on maintenance and deterioration.

CONCEPT & MATERIAL

The Artist will provide a design concept to guide an identified community or creative group to participate in the creation of the wraps. This will be achieved through the temporary wrapping in a textile (natural or artificial fibres) and utilising weaving, knitting, crochet, knotting, braiding or tufting techniques.
